Hello Parents/Guardians and Students,

I know there are many questions about school closure and what happens next regarding the end of the Module 3 grades, new student orientation, and other planned school activities. As of today, March 31, 2020, we will return to school when the Philadelphia School District returns to school. Over the next few weeks, we will be monitoring the situation and making a decision based on guidance from our Governor and the School District of Philadelphia. According to guidance from the Pennsylvania Department of Education and the School District of Philadelphia we can only provide students with optional enrichment activities to complete during this time. Please visit our New Google Classroom on our website to find these optional enrichment activities for your child. In addition, we have set up a link on our website with information on how to access Zoom via the website or app for virtual hours. On Zoom students can check in with key school personnel to ask questions and to provide support during this time.

If you do not have technology to access these enrichment activities, we are here to help. We are extending an invitation to families to participate in the Chromebook loaner program to ensure all students have access to online materials during the school closure. If your child(ren) does not have access to a device at home, we will be establishing 4 pick up locations across the city during the week of April 13th, 2020. Once we have confirmation of delivery of the Chromebooks we will post more information regarding Chromebooks on our website, email via those who have signed up for email notification, Instagram and via PowerSchool announcements.

I understand that this might be a hard and unusual time, but note you are not alone, as everyone in the city and our country is experiencing this with us. Our effort is geared towards trying our best to get your child(ren) back on track to earning credits towards graduation.
